

Educational reforms

Education is the most important pillar in the strengthening and growth of a country. But unfortunately the education system of Pakistan has not been upto the mark. Due to a number of challenges in this system, the outcome is not that as it should be. Here listed are a few steps that if taken can enhance the learning and education.

★ Focusing on quality rather than quantity :

Instead, first standardizing the already present educational institutions, making access of children to schools easy, and creating a student friendly learning environment should be the first priority.

★ Teachers' training and check and balance :

Sadly, the curriculum and the teaching staff isn't compatible as for example in government schools. Training programs should be held according to international standards and there should be a check on the methodology of teaching and the ways knowledge is being delivered.

★ Making higher education accessible to all :

Referring to point 1, not just we need to give basic education to all, access to higher education must be made easy for everyone.

Students who are studying with no plans for the future, they don't have the required motivation to study.

★ Uniformity in education :

The curriculum, the teaching methods, the facilities being provided in the institutions, must be uniform and should be provided to all despite the differences.

These steps, if taken can markedly enhance the learning skills and make education something fruitful in real sense.
